Clinical features extracted from the case and entered into the query box:

fever

lower abdominal, scrotum and groin pain

fatique

low back pain

dysuria

eye pain

lightheaded

hyperferritinemia

elevated CRP level

normal ESR level

cytopenia

elevated triglyceride level
